## Carpenters (Journeyman and Apprentice) –Cranbrook and Kimberley, BC

### QUALIFICATIONS AND EDUCATION REQUIREMENTS

- Must be fully vaccinated against COVID-19
- High school diploma
- Journeyman or Apprentice Carpenter
- Post-secondary certificate in construction is an asset
- Minimum 3+ years' experience as a carpenter
- Criminal Record Check may be required to work on some sites

### PREFERRED SKILLS

- Knowledge of commercial construction and remodeling trades, practices, procedures, techniques, tools and equipment, materials, specifications, and safety
- Able to organize assigned tasks for completion alone or with help
- Proven written and verbal communication abilities
- Ability to read, understand, and interpret contract documents, drawings, specifications, scopes of work, and project schedules

### RESPONSIBILITIES

- Frame walls and erect scaffolding, prepare layouts, measure, cut, shape, assemble, and join wood materials
- Build foundations, floor beams and subflooring, install framing for dropped ceilings and bulk heads
- Insulate, drywall, mud/tape, and paint
- Erect roof rafters and sheathing, work at heights
- Build porches, verandas, post beams and decks, custom stairs, and exterior wood siding/soffit/fascia
- Erect wood framework, walls, partitions, joints, drywall, and rafters
- Install doors and windows, floor coverings, ceilings, and trim
- Check accuracy of work and make adjustments as required
- Read blueprints for work planning

## WORKING CONDITIONS

- Construction environment (regularly working near moving mechanical parts and in outside conditions that include inclement weather, heat and humidity, exposure to dust, asphalt, and noise)
- Working with various tools and materials
- Lifting, pulling or pushing, carrying, and manipulating objects up to 50 lbs
- Walking and standing for long periods of time
- Climbing ladders, crawling
- Use of Personal Protective Equipment will be required (e.g. hard-hat, safety boots, etc.)
